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This sassy 13" wide x 14 1/2" tall and 5" deep bag makes a perfect tote for everyday adventures, a day of shopping, or even antiquing. With four different design options for the front and back triangles, each tote you make can be completely different. Use scraps for the triangle section and add a bit more fabric for the rest of the bag. In class you will focus on piecing the accent triangle. Bag completion will be demonstrated.
