This is the second in Darlene's template quilt series. Just as there are with many other patterns, there are many ways to get Flying Geese. The Flying Geese ruler from Eleanor Burns makes cutting and sewing geese easier and more accurate. The ruler contains two sizes. Darlene chose the larger size and found it was fun to stitch such large pieces. After you have the geese made, there are many ways to set them. Darlene chose to make twelve 16" squares of eight geese. To make the geese a little different she added four folded triangles to the centers creating a whirly gig. Make her design or one square would make a great pillow, or use three or four squares for a table runner.
