You will learn a math formula for cutting the half square triangles along the edge and the quarter square triangles on the corners of the striking diagonal setting.

Mary Beth always thought origami should be done with fabric. Leesa Chandler took it a step further and actually produced exquisite projects featuring an origami insert. In class, you will learn how to fold the fabric, press, and how to fold again to make Leesa's dimensional blocks. You will then learn how to border the blocks so they can be incorporated into the runner (or one of the other four items detailed in the pattern). Consider using Leesa's Textile Pantry fabrics for a really elegant result.
