Using a dark, in this case a black solid background, makes the solid bright colors pop. You will use a method somewhat like piecing half square triangles, only using rectangles. Darlene learned the technique just for the class sample. You will have an easier time piecing than she did! If you have a kaleidoscope, bring it to class - she is bringing hers!

It provides ample storage space for any project or hobby—quilting, drawing, hand-sewing and so much more! The inside features a zippered pouch, mesh zippered pocket, and elastics for holding pens or other items. Best of all, the bottom of the case has an elastic buckle strap to hold quilt blocks, books, or rulers. With prep work before class, you will be able to get a quick start and complete the bag during the second session. The bag finishes 14" x 13" wide and 3" deep.. It should be a must for every quilter.
