Me and My Sister, designers from Moda Fabrics have created a fabulous method for making double wide Dresden plates that are just wonderful. These Dresden's are finished both on the top inner and outer edge, pieced one to the next, and then machine stitched onto the background to make a completely different looking design. Using a jellyroll, or forty 2 1/2" strips, along with two additional fabrics, you can create fifteen of these addictive blocks - enough for an amazing 60 1/2" square quilt.

Using a dark, in this case a black solid background, makes the solid bright colors pop. You will use a method somewhat like piecing half square triangles, only using rectangles. Darlene learned the technique just for the class sample. You will have an easier time piecing than she did! If you have a kaleidoscope bring it to class - she is bringing hers!

Laura will also share her sewing and pressing techniques so the end result will be a perfect "flat" block. Oh, no layer cakes or charm packs? No problem - Laura also figured out the yardage for straight cut fabric. The pattern makes a 68" x 68" quilt which Laura tweaked to 59" x 68".
