Beginning the first day of summer, visit any participating Row by Row shop (and there are thousands in the US, Canada and Europe!) and receive a free pattern for a row design that features the 2017 theme - Row by Row on the Go! Each shop interprets the theme in their own way - it is so much fun to see what each has done. If you have participated before, you won't be surprised to see our row has a Pittsburgh vive. You can see the results of my vintage trolley research during the hop (and if you have never been, you really should visit the Trolley Museum - so much history and so much fun!). You can even win a prize from one of the shops. You gather rows, make a quilt featuring eight of the 2017 rows and then return to a shop that has not had their prize claimed. The prize is a stack of 25 fat quarters! If that shop's row is in your quilt you win an additional prize - in our case an additional 29 fat quarters and a \$29.00 gift certificate to celebrate the beginning of our 29th year!



### ***And ~ new for 2017 Row by Row Junior!***

This hop is the work of the same group that began the first Row by Row hop in 2011. This part of the hop is for young people (children 6-14). This year they can pick up their very own row pattern. The rows have been developed and written by Row by Row staff just for them. Our row features Rover - a colorful pieced pooch. There are hop ribbons for the first five children back to the shop with a finished row (and sets of four coordinated fat quarters from us). Keep in mind these rows are for children - you can still make them (getting the pattern by purchasing a kit), you can even put them in your 2017 quilt, but they do not count toward the eight rows you must include to win a prize.



I can't tell you how excited I was to see the new Buck-a-Block program from Thangles. I have always loved their concise piecing method and designs, but this one is incredible! Mary Beth Hayes has created a contemporary style quilt that will be worked over the course of five months. The 57 1/2" x 80" piece will be offered in two different colorways (we have to admit her models were so spectacular we are going to use her options!) - blue, green, gray and snow or red, yellow, green, blue and gray. Each month you will receive piecing fabrics for ten blocks - both background and foreground fabrics! You will add border fabric and binding fabric. Pictures of the quilts, the pattern and Thangles for your quilt will be included in your registration packet. I can't wait to begin stitching!
